

CDR Expand their Ordnance Survey portfolio

Ordnance Survey launched their new Pricing and Licensing Model at the end of 2010, which aims to enable greater access to its products and geographic datasets under a simplified structure.

Among the changes to be presented is the introduction of terms to allow partner businesses to licence and resell almost all Ordnance Survey products, including its flagship dataset, OS MasterMap Topography Layer. Partners will also have greater flexibility in how they can onward license Ordnance Survey products, with the choice of how much or how little they want to include in their offerings. This will give customers greater choice of where they source their Ordnance Survey data.

CDR has signed up to the provision of the new datasets, which includes; 1:10,000 scale raster, Points of Interest, LandForm Profile+, OS MasterMap Topography and Integrated Transport Network.

When combined with the free availability of data through OS OpenData, the new pricing and licensing model means high quality digital mapping has never been more accessible. Indeed, CDR has already supplied the new data to clients in the New Year.
