

Upgrade offer for “old” MapInfo licences

Have you got an old version of MapInfo Professional?

If you have version 10 or earlier then you would not usually be eligible for an upgrade price. Pitney Bowes Software is pleased to announce an amnesty on upgrading really old versions of MapInfo Professional until September 27th 2013. So you can upgrade for less than the full price of a new licence but only for a limited time...

Benefits:

The changes in one version of MapInfo Professional may be difficult to justify but when there have been over 4 version changes – this represents some vast changes, particularly with the Layer Control and Browser window. Microsoft is dropping support for Windows XP at the end of this year and we have seen many customers moving their version of Windows up to v7 at least. You can be assured that MapInfo v12.0 works with Windows 8 and Office 2013.

Otherwise, there are just too many improvements to list here.

The upgrade will also get you back onto a Maintenance And Technical Support contract – so you will automatically receive v12.5 next summer and that will be a full 64 bit application.

Upgrading to Windows 7?

Many of our customers are moving to Windows 7 this year and need to know which is the minimum version of MapInfo that is compatible. Answer: MapInfo version 10.0.1
