32 and 64 bit versions

For the first time, MapInfo Professional will be available in both a 32 bit and full 64 bit version. 64 bit support allows for the full use of the computers processor capabilities.

Additional data format support

Using the "Open Universal Data" capability and the FME Quick Translator, MapInfo Professional users can work with data in the following formats:

- ESRI GeoDatabase (open/import and export)
- Geography Markup Language (GML) versions 2.1.2, 3.1.1 and 3.2.1 (open/import)
- Geography Markup Language Simple Features Level SF-0 Profile (export)

The 32-bit version has now been released with the 64-bit version to follow in October.
