

OS MasterMap Highways in MapInfo and RouteFinder

Ordnance Survey has recently introduced OS MasterMap Highways data and this will eventually be replacing the older Integrated Transport Network. OS MasterMap Highways Network provides all the highways data you need, in one place. It's a new, common and authoritative view of the whole road network in Great Britain, ideal for routing and public sector data-sharing.

Our friends at Routeware have now developed a translator for the Routing and Asset Management Information (RAMI). For vehicle routing and navigation software providers, this data gives you all you need to get your users safely to their destinations: turn, height, weight and width restrictions – and even bollards and traffic calming. The translator selects the relevant data and constructs MapInfo tables for use in RouteFinder for MapInfo.

National coverage contains nearly 4.8 million road links and this is where 64-bit computing really shows it's worth when you need to do some network analysis or any of the routing functions in RouteFinder. If you haven't upgraded to MapInfo version 16 with RouteFinder version 5 yet, this is surely the justification to do it with the marked improvement in performance.
